Hospice vs. Home Health vs. Palliative Care



Within post-acute care, there are many special services made to help and comfort people with certain medical needs. Three important types of care that often mix and connect are hospice care, home health care, and palliative care. While these services all aim to improve life quality for sick people, they are different in their goals, who can use them, what benefits are included, and how long they last.
